
Our Guide to the Exuberant Nonsense of College Fight Songs










The color corresponds to the school's primary color. The length of the line corresponds to the number of clichés found in each song (there were 9 possible, but the most instances was from Rutgers with 8 clichés in their song).



FiveThirtyEight examined the lyrics of 65 college "fight songs," all of which are seen here. They pulled out 9 clichés found in all but three of the songs (clichés represented by the shapes to the right). The most common instance was "fight" with 44 out of the 65 songs using it at least once.

The shapes themselves are arbitrary but their order is consistent. This arrangement allows the viewe visually compare the number of clichés used as compared to the other songs, as well as look further and determine the actual categories.
