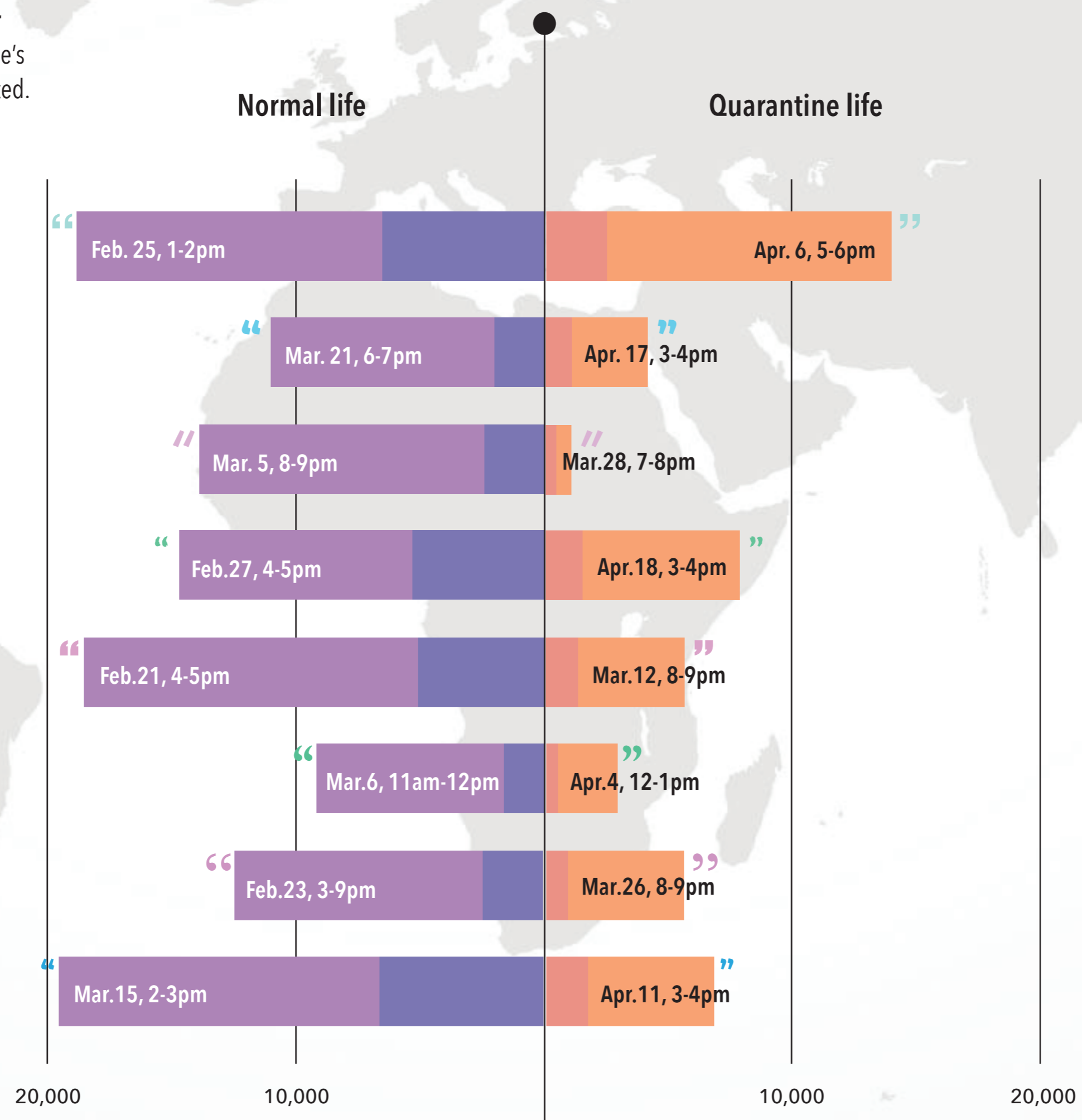


# "STEPS" DATA COLLECTION

This graph compares and contrasts the amount of foot-steps eight college students took **before** and **after** their personal "switchover date" - the day when one's normal college life ended and quarantine life started.

- avg. amount of steps in a month before switchover
- highest amount of steps in a month before switchover
- avg. amount of steps in a month after switchover
- highest amount of steps in a month after switchover
- geographical locations before switchover
- geographical locations after switchover
